The plain folders are very, very inexpensive and are the easiest for them to use in class. One last request is that your child brings in sanitation wipes, not baby wipes. They use these all year to wipe down their desks and chairs. I have found in doing so, there are less absences due to illness. I let the children use their CD players during individual work time. They are welcome to bring in their own CD, as well as use the class CD library that is full of grade appropriate music. The CD players really help most students to focus on their work. ☺
