We encourage parents to help support the uniform policy, while keeping in mind our mission, our identity, and pride of being a part of our community.

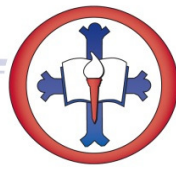
Boys/Girls

- Shirts** Polo or button down dress shirts in solid red, white, or blue color only. Long sleeve or turtle neck shirts in solid red, white, or blue may be worn under school shirts, no visible logo except St. Agatha school logo. Shirts must be tucked in for developmentally appropriate age level; K-2nd grades not fully enforced, 3rd - 8th grade strictly enforced.
- Sweaters** Pullover or Cardigan solid red, white, or blue collared shirt must be visible. No visible logo except St. Agatha School logo.
- Sweatshirts or Fleece** Crew neck or V-neck, ¼ zip collar solid red, white, or blue color St. Agatha School logo or CYO approved St. Agatha Storm logo only
- Pants** Kindergarten - 8th grade solid navy blue or khaki slacks, cotton twill/blend or corduroy plain or pleat front.
- Shorts** Kindergarten- 8th grade solid navy blue, khaki slacks or Hamilton Plaid, cotton twill/blend or corduroy plain or pleat front. Must be between knee length, and no higher than 2" above the knee.
- Hats & Coats** Coats/Outerwear must be removed when entering the classroom, hooded sweatshirts worn due to weather conditions must be removed when entering the classroom, non-uniform coats, jackets, and sweatshirts must be removed when entering the classroom. No hats in the classroom unless approved for spirit days.

Girls

- Jumpers/ Skirts/Skortis** Solid navy blue, Hamilton Plaid or Khaki, must be between knee length and no higher than 2" above the knee.
- Socks** Solid red, white, or blue tights free of holes, no leggings, socks solid white, blue, or black color. Socks must be visible

Jewelry No obnoxious jewelry that interferes with the educational environment is allowed, no earrings can hang below the ear, one ring per hand, one bracelet per arm, on simple necklace.

Shoes Dress shoes brown or black, tennis shoes are allowed solid white, blue, tan, brown or black color, no loud colored or neon colored shoes. Mary Jane's, t-strap style, heels must be shorter than 1" tall, NO BOOTS, NO UGS in the classroom, may be worn to school but must be changed prior to the start of school.

Hair Natural color, above the eyes, hair clips or bands must be solid color red, white, blue, Hamilton Plaid, brown or black.

Boys

Socks Must be visible, solid white, black or brown color.

Shoes Dress shoes or tennis shoes are allowed solid white, blue, or black color. No loud or neon colored shoes allowed.

Hair Natural color must be above the eyes, ears and collar.

Physical Education

Shoes Non-marking soled shoes for PE - All grades

Grades 5th - 8th grade

Athletic shorts must be no more than 2 inches above the knee for boys and girls; St. Agatha School issued PE shirts only. Socks must be worn and visible.
